BADINGHAM VILLAGE HALL

Draft Minutes of the Meeting held on Friday 23 September 2022 at 7.00 pm

in Badingham Village Hall, Low Street, Badingham IP13 8JT

Attended by 34 members of the public from the village of Badingham, and the Parish Council Chair and Clerk.

- **1. Welcome:** The Chair of the Parish Council, Cllr Mountain, welcomed everyone to the meeting in the absence of any properly constituted Village Hall Management Committee.
- 2. Minutes of the last VH AGM and matters arising: The AGM minutes from the last meeting were not available at the time. Note post meeting an Annual Report was found but no actual AGM minutes, therefore no matters arising. An Agenda was posted for 16 July 2019 but no minutes can be located from that meeting, if it did indeed, take place.
- **3.** Exceptional Report on the Year by the Chair of the Parish Council: Cllr Mountain gave an overview of what has led to today's meeting. He briefly outlined the decision tree that was to be voted on at the meeting. He thanked Cllr Horrocks and his wife for all their hard work in keeping the hall open. The floor was thrown open to members of the public present for a question and answer session about the current state of affairs.
- 4. Exceptional Financial Report by the Parish Clerk: The Clerk confirmed the VH was operating at a loss and has been since the Pre-School found alternative premises. The Pre-School income of over £9K was greater than expenditure, which added to other hire fees, meant the VH operated at a profit pre-Covid, and showed a healthy profit year on year. With the loss of this income stream, the hall is operating at a severe loss. The accounts for the year ending 31 March 2022 as prepared by Cllr Horrocks and audited by T. Brown, a well-known auditor, show the current account balance was £3673.27 at 31/3/22. This reduced to £1435.20 in the 5 months to 31/8/22. Expenditure was estimated at approx. £8K per annum as detailed in the Budget forecast below:
